
### Hackathon Overview

FOSS stands for Free and Open Source
Software. The term "free" refers to freedom, not just price—meaning users have the right to use, modify, and distribute the software as they wish. Open source means the source code is publicly available, allowing anyone to improve, and share it.

Users can use, modify, and share the software without restrictions. FOSS is built on the principles of transparency, collaboration, and user control



Unlike proprietary software, FOSS is **community-driven, transparent, and secure**. It prevents vendor lock-in, promotes innovation, and powers major technologies like Linux, Firefox, Blender, and LibreOffice.
